

How to Use Coffee Grounds for Hydrangeas

- 1. Suse Only Spent Grounds: Always use brewed (used) coffee grounds, never fresh ones they're safer and less acidic.
- 2. **(a) Apply in Moderation:** Sprinkle 1-2 tablespoons per plant around the base, staying 5 cm from the stem.
- 3. *** Mix into the Soil:** Gently work the grounds into the topsoil to avoid crusting and improve aeration.
- 4. **Water Thoroughly:** Water the area well to activate nutrients and help them reach the roots.
- 5. **K Combine with Compost:** For better results, mix coffee grounds with compost or mulch to balance nutrients and moisture.
- 6. <u>Soil pH:</u> If aiming for blue flowers, ensure soil pH is between 5.2 and 5.5. Adjust as needed.
- 7. **TRepeat as Needed:** Reapply every 4-6 weeks during the growing season for lasting benefits.
