



How to Use Coffee Grounds for Hydrangeas

1. ☕ **Use Only Spent Grounds:** Always use brewed (used) coffee grounds, never fresh ones - they're safer and less acidic.
2. 📦 **Apply in Moderation:** Sprinkle 1-2 tablespoons per plant around the base, staying 5 cm from the stem.
3. 🌱 **Mix into the Soil:** Gently work the grounds into the topsoil to avoid crusting and improve aeration.
4. 💧 **Water Thoroughly:** Water the area well to activate nutrients and help them reach the roots.
5. 🌿 **Combine with Compost:** For better results, mix coffee grounds with compost or mulch to balance nutrients and moisture.
6. 🔬 **Check Soil pH:** If aiming for blue flowers, ensure soil pH is between 5.2 and 5.5. Adjust as needed.
7. 📅 **Repeat as Needed:** Reapply every 4-6 weeks during the growing season for lasting benefits.

💡 Tip: Combine with mulch for better results and water retention.
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
