



## How to Transplant a Hydrangea (Step-by-Step Guide)

1. 📍 **Choose the right location:** Pick a spot with partial shade and well-draining soil.
2. 🪓 **Prepare the new hole:** Dig a hole twice as wide as the root ball, amend with compost.
3. 💧 **Water before digging:** Soak the plant a day or two before transplanting to reduce stress.

8. 🔍 **Monitor for shock:** Watch for wilting or yellowing and provide shade or extra water as needed.
