

How to Choose the Right Hydrangea (Online or In-Store)

- 1. **Check the Label:** Confirm it's a garden hydrangea, not a florist one. Look for hardy varieties like *macrophylla*, *paniculata*, or *arborescens*.
- 2. Assess Flower Type: Decide between mophead, lacecap, or panicle based on your garden style and colour preferences.
- 3. **If Buying Online:** Read customer reviews, look at packaging photos, and confirm plant size (not just pot size).
- 4. ***** Check Root Health: In-store, gently lift the pot to check for well-developed but not rootbound roots.
- 5. **K Inspect Leaves & Stems:** Avoid plants with yellowing, wilted, or spotty leaves. Look for strong, green growth.
- 6. **Consider Mature Size:** Make sure the plant's adult size suits your space some hydrangeas grow up to 2m wide!
- 7. *Know Your Soil:* If you want blue flowers, your soil should be acidic (or use ericaceous compost in pots).
- 8. **Shop in Season:** Spring and early summer are best. Avoid heatwaves or frost periods for new planting.
