

## How to Grow and Care for Hydrangea macrophylla

- 1. **Soak the root ball:** Submerge the plant pot in water until no bubbles rise.
- 2. **Choose the right location:** Pick a spot with morning sun and afternoon shade.
- 3. **• Prepare the soil:** Ensure well-draining, slightly acidic soil rich in organic matter.
- 4. **Y Plant with care:** Dig a wide hole, place the plant, and backfill gently.
- 5. **Water thoroughly:** Keep soil consistently moist, especially in dry periods.
- 6. *A* **Mulch around the base:** Use organic mulch to retain moisture and prevent weeds.
- 7. **Y Prune in spring:** Only remove dead wood and faded blooms after frost risk is over.
- 8. *Adjust pH*: Use aluminum sulfate for blue blooms or lime for pink flowers.
- 9. **½ Fertilise moderately:** Apply balanced fertiliser in spring and summer.
- 10. **Protect in winter:** Mulch heavily and avoid pruning before winter.
